Dear Members

There will be a picnic for the member of the MHGDC to be held on Saturday August 6, 2005. The location for the event is the Gallatin Sporting Clays Range in Logan. The club will furnish the meat and soft drinks and we are asking members to bring salads and deserts. Shooters should be on the range by 3:30 and finish by 6:00 p.m. for our bar-b-que.

Several discussions regarding the Training opportunities for the pointers have been had with this being a quick summary of the issues and possible solutions. Please feel free to let us know about your needs and desires along with any solutions you might have. All letters except anonymous letters will be brought to the next board meeting and read so let us know you feelings.

The problem seems to center on the availability to train where we have permission to use pen raised game birds on Saturday. The spaniels train almost all year long and the pointers usually start training when day light savings starts in the beginning of April. A group of dedicated people from the pointing group however begins training for trials much earlier in the year when there is not enough daylight after work for meaningful training sessions. As conveyed to me the spaniel group would make every effort from January and throughout the rest of the year to be completely done with their sessions by 1:00P.M. So the pointers can use the training grounds for the remainder of the day. Simple communication between the groups should resolve any problems. However, if the pointers want to train on Saturdays they will need more volunteers.

Additional training grounds would be desirable. If anyone has suggestions for training grounds please contact any board member.

The club has equipment used for training and for putting on club events. We are trying to locate all the equipment not relocate the equipment. Suggestions go from leave things as they are to rent storage in a more central location. Comments are welcome.

The meeting of the MHGDC Board of Directors was called to order at 7:05 PM.

President's Report: None

Secretary's Report: Minutes were read from the 4/19/05 meeting and approved.

Treasurer's Report: Savings-\$11,836.00, checking - \$6,484.00.

Pointers: Fun trial dates: July 16, August 6 at training grounds. All events begin at 7:00 AM. Training on Thursday evenings beginning at 5:00 PM. NSTRA-Great Falls Aug 27 & 28. Recent fun trial placements: Keven Edwards/Sage 1st place; Melody Kaelin/Callie 2nd place; Dave Kirkland/Hallie 3rd place (2nd and 3rd place resulting from 5-way tie).

Spaniels: Flushing dog fun trials May 14, June 11, July 9, August 20. Held at training grounds, begin at 8:00 AM. AKC Hunt test September 17-18. Training Saturday AM.

Retrievers: Flushing dog fun trials July 9, August 20. Held at training grounds, begin at 8:00 AM. AKC Hunt Test in Butte July 30 & 31. Pat needs help in the way of throwers, live shooters, Marshals.

Unfinished Business: MHGDC Web page is up and running. Check it out - MHGDC.org.

Pheasant Championship tentatively scheduled for Aug 28. Eric Kaelin will be in Great Falls at NSTRA, so it might be canceled.

Open Training Day very successful. Bryan Blatt will look at changing format for next year to be more focused on hunting.

Investment vehicle-Sam presented an example of different types of investments (stocks, bonds, mutual funds), historic returns, and length of time investment should be held. Board members want to know about CD's as well. Discussion to be continued at next Board meeting.

The club is missing 4 large orange bird crates. Please let Randy know if you have any of them. We need them back ASAP!!

New training grounds: Bryan Blatt will chair a committee to begin a more formal search for an additional location the club can use for training. He's looking for other club members to help him with this endeavor. Call him at 388-5720. Board will continue discussion at next board meeting.

Need to receive training equipment list from retriever and spaniel groups to compile equipment inventory.

Authorized purchase of bird "pliers" to dispatch birds.

New Business:

Board approved an annual donation of \$250 to a conservation organization to be used as a memorial fund. The organization will be selected annually. This memorial donation is to honor members of our club who passed away during the year. The board wishes to acknowledge the recent passing of Floyd Ball.

Equipment use for events other than MHGDC events. Board discussed whether our equipment should be lent out to other groups. Board believes that its OK to loan to groups such as parent clubs when our members are participating in the event, or Boy Scouts, etc. as long as one of our members attends the event and is responsible for the equipment. No motion was made. Discussion to be continued before full board.

The Board passed a motion to require a porta-potty be present during all MHGDC events held at the training grounds, including fun trials. Sam will find out from FWP whether we can keep a porta-potty at the training grounds throughout the summer training season, and have it regularly serviced.

Summer picnic at Gallatin Sporting Clays. Sam will look at calendar, set a date and time and let Tracy know for the newsletter. Club members can buy a round of shooting or use one of their sporting clays tickets if a GSC member. MHGDC will provide a main dish, sodas, water. BYO salads, desserts, beer, wine.

The meeting adjourned at 9:35 PM.

Spring trials are over and they finished with a bang. I am new to NSTRA myself and I thought other MHGDC members, (especially the pointer group) would be interested in how the pointers of MHGDC performed. Here are the results since the last newsletter as reported in the board meeting minutes of 4/19/2005.

In Polson on April 24th Conrad Kradolfer / Diva came home with a 1st place finish. Diva by the way was about one month pregnant. The next weekend in Acton the "True Grit Brits" ruled and brought home some "major hardware". On Saturday (4/30/05) Mark Donovan/Rusty placed 1st and won the "High Point" trophy. Sunday (5/1/05) was even more exiting with Tana Kradolfer/Pie (owned by Dale Sweetser) placing 1st and winning the "High Point" trophy, as well as placing 3rd on field B.
